Dates have been set for March 31—April 14, 2016 for a second mission trip to Lima, Peru to assist Steve and Kelley Frerichs. I will be leading the group. Our plan is to serve in Lima as opportunities open, to assist with a building project in the community two hours south of Lima, where we helped on our first visit and to hold outreach services in the highlands where Steve and Kelley desire to see a new church started. We need your prayer for the following:

- That housing and travel plans will come together
- Health and safety for all on the team
- That language and culture differences would not hinder
- That all financial needs would be met

We were able to help the Frerichs family with a special financial gift on our last trip that al-

lowed them to purchase a desperately needed washer and dryer. We would like to be able to bless them this trip as well. Any funds given beyond expenses will go toward this gift of encouragement. Not everyone will be impressed or able to give, but all can pray with and for us. If God impresses and enables you to give toward this adventure, simply note that with your gift. I would also like to purchase another ventriloquist tool to take with us that I think would be quite effective in drawing a crowd together. This is a remote controlled mask that turns a spectator into an instant vent figure ("dummy"). This is quite expensive, but would be a great attraction and provide opportunities to present the Gospel. LOCATION: Valley Bible Church, Spokane Valley, WA.


With our mission trip to Peru scheduled just before our original workshop date, we have moved our meeting back one week from our initial plans.
