Thoughts from Diane . . . Tragedy

My mom had an unusual upbringing. She didn't share with me often, but occasionally something would spark a memory. She absolutely loved her Dad. She was devastated when he passed away in his sixties. She would always make sure to tell me she looked just like him. I was young when he died but I have a distant memory of crawling up on his lap and snuggling close to him. My family was not affectionate, but I do remember Grandpa Larson's kind smile.

However, Mom had other memories that were horrible. She remembered being locked in a closet by her cousin who wouldn't let her out. My Grandmother, in order to run errands alone, locked Mom on the porch and left her there for hours. Mom grew up very scared of small places.



There was another memory she shared with me once. She told me she had been sexually violated by her brother. This is something she carried with her the rest of her life. Somehow, she was able to communicate with him over time, but I knew this traumatic event haunted her. It had very negative affects on her marriage. I remember being told, "Well, she was hard to live with." My mother didn't know Christ as her personal Savior when she shared these hurts and I'm uncertain that she ever did. What terrible memories she had to suffer; we all have some of those. Even worse, she didn't have a Savior to bear her hurt and pain.

There's a story in the life of King David who had a daughter named Tamar. It's found in II Samuel 13. Tamar's half-brother lusted after her. He devised a plan with "a very crafty friend" who helped him get what he wanted. (verses 11 & 12) . . . As she was feeding him (he pretended to be ill) he grabbed her and demanded, 'Come to bed with me, my sister.'" "Don't my brother! she said to him. Don't force me. Such a thing should not be done in Israel! Don't do this wicked thing. Where could I get rid of my disgrace?" He was stronger than her and raped her. Scripture tells us he was filled with lust, not love. This kind of lust brings shame, disgust and alters people minds and lives in ways unimaginable.

No one deserves to have terrible things happen to them. Many have had abominable acts forced on them, not of their own choosing. The breath and depth of an individual's depravity knows no bounds. God's Word tells us "For **ALL** have sinned and come short of the glory of God" Romans 3:23. I could see that because of the terrible acts Mom had done to her, she couldn't imagine that she needed to be forgiven. I shared the gospel over and over with her through the years. When she faced death and was in a coma, she suddenly opened her eyes and looked terrified. I whispered in her ear, "Mom, cry out to Jesus." She responded, "I did." Those were her last words to me. It was what God gave me and I was thankful for that much. Only God knows the outcome and her heart.

God said, "Come to me all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." Matthew 11:28 . We are **ALL** burdened with the same sinful nature. We are **ALL** capable of unimaginable sinful acts. We **ALL** need to know Jesus personally. Perhaps you say you're not capable of the acts of sin I mentioned, the harsh truth is, we are **ALL** sinful. When we come to know Him, we realize the comfort and peace we can have in recognizing that Jesus as our Savior. He died for you. He will comfort you. He has provided that for me as well as for you, for us **ALL**.

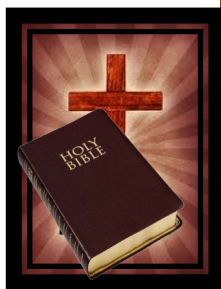
