DIANE'S HEALTH UPDATE



Diane has not wanted me to keep mentioning her health challenges, but we need you to know and understand what's happening so you can uphold us in prayer. Her adventure has involved the better part of the past six years. Along with asthma, she has been hospitalized six times, had repeated sinus infections and at least twenty-six diagnosed bouts of pneumonia. She has been in emergency over twenty times (we lost track). Most recently, since April, if she has not been on an antibiotic, she has been running a fever. Even after the fourteen days of IV infusion with a strong antibiotic, she was infected again within three days following treatment. The infections involve both her sinuses and lungs. She currently is fighting another round of pneumonia. As for most humans, breathing is an important habit. 📜

We met with an infectious disease specialist today. It took two months to see this doctor. He has prescribed two antibiotics to be taken simultaneously for a ten week period. We have thought in the past that the dosage has not been strong enough or long enough. All we seem to have done in the past is to make the bacteria angry and they just fight back. Diane has had three sinus surgeries and the ENT doctor does not believe there is any further surgery that will help. The infections usually have started in the sinus cavities. We are praying that this latest treatment will help her.

She also has all the symptoms of pleurisy, which is very painful, has had difficulty breathing and extreme fatigue. This has made her very discouraged. We are praying that this antibiotic regiment has a beneficial effect. As we are sure you are aware, the enemy knows where, how and when to attack us. If he can keep us discouraged and defeated, he tends to silence our voices as to the goodness of God. We will continue doing what we know God wants us to do, convinced that He has a Master plan. 2 Corinthians 4:1 "Therefore, since through God's mercy we have this ministry, we do not lose heart." RESIST

"RIGHTEOUS RESISTANCE"

"resist" - to exert force in opposition; to exert oneself so as to counteract or defeat. I am trying to understand. All this "resistance" ultimately accomplishes is to deepen the divide in our country. 
