 - Keep a supply of ESM brochures, etc. to hand out.
 - Set a goal to contact 1 or 2 churches a month by phone, letter, e-mail or personal visit.
 - Be certain your home church/Pastor knows about ESM
 - Help us schedule church contacts and opportunities to present the work of our ministry.
 - Let us know of churches/Pastors we may be able to serve.
- Give financially as the Lord enables you.
 - Encourage other individuals to invest in our ministry.
 - Encourage churches to consider monthly support.
 - Help us learn of ways to broaden our support base.
- Keep in contact via e-mail as much as possible
- Ask God for ideas to help expand our ministry and effectiveness
- Help with pricing of equipment needs
- Assist with any conferences or workshops we plan as your schedule permits.
- Be sensitive to God's leadership for potential new board members.
- Make us aware of the needs of widows or Pastors and their family
- If God redirects in your life, and board membership is no longer possible, let us know as soon as God makes that clear.
- Pray regularly for our ministry.
 - When your schedule permits, attend prayer times as announced.
 - o Share ESM requests with your church and prayer groups.

 - Pray for financial needs.
