Some believe that according to the ancient Mayan's, 2012 will mark the end of the world as we know it. What should we expect on December 21, 2012, when the

Maya's "Long Count" calendar marks the end of a 5,126-year era? Part of the 2012 mystique relates to the stars. According to journalist Lawrence Joseph, on the winter solstice in 2012, the sun will be aligned with the center of the Milky Way for the first time in about 26,000 years. This means that "whatever energy typically streams to Earth from the center of the Milky Way will be disrupted on 12.21.12 at 11:11 p.m. Universal Time."




