testing for a potential white blood cell problem. Her white count may be normal, but the white cells may not be functioning properly. This may help to find a solution to the continuing infections.



weak and angry. I was also busy growling in frustration that several doctors haven't found any answers to my questions. A year and a half later there still aren't any solutions. Then, adding to all of it, is the fact that we have a very ill, adult son. I want to be healthy so I can be a help and be an encouragement to him and beyond that, to be an encouragement to others. I'm not much fun or even enjoyable to be around a lot of the time. In all of this, I've allowed distance to grow between myself and God.

I know if I've experienced pain and allowed it to become an excuse to neglect my relationship with God then there may be others who've done the same. Reasons may differ but the result is the same. Broken relationships hurt the one who loves them and the one who creates the separation. Anger, stubbornness, frustration or hurt that causes separation is something that needs to be dealt with.
