From the inception of Eagle Summit, our friends, Ray and Donna Eberle, provided us with office space at their law office for only \$50 a month. That may have covered utility costs. We were able to stay in that space for seven-

teen years. Ray passed away in October of 2011. The building had been donated to the Union Gospel Mission and eventually sold. Since the sale about a year ago, we have been without an office space. My desk and most of my books and files have been in storage.

We decided to set up an office at home. We have delayed do-

ing so because of the possibility of our son and grandson coming to live with us. If that does happen, we will rearrange. It is nice to have an official workspace once again. Because the office space is smaller, I am forced to go through forty years of files. This involves sorting through hundreds of files, deleting what is no longer relevant and refiling what is still useful. This involves six file cabinets, a total of twenty-four drawers. I am also deciding what books to keep and what to give away. Six bookshelves filled with books will not fit into three shelves.

Fifty plus boxes need to be gone through. Thankfully, the timing is perfect. December is



generally the slowest month of the year in relation to ministry opportunities. Because of Christmas break, there are no school bus driving responsibilities and we had already decided not to travel out of town to visit family. It is good to be forced now to sort out what is still relevant rather than wait for another twenty years. Much of my library is now on my computer, so sorting out what books I actually need is ideal.

Thoughts from Diane . . . COMMUNICATION

There was a time, at the beginning of the 2002, when we had lost communication with our youngest son. A year had gone by and we had heard nothing of him or from him. He was on my mind all of the time. The longer the span of time, the more burdened we became. It was the spring of that year that I was on an extra bus trip. It was before I carried any wireless technology and many hours of no way to communicate loomed before me. All I could do was pray (not such a bad



thing). I prayed, I prayed more. Hours went by and I begged God to let me hear from my son before the day ended. The scene is still very vivid in my mind. I went home that night and George was gone for work as well. It was just before midnight and I was still up; I felt so alone. Then the phone rang. It was Benjamin. Can you possibly imagine how much I praised God? It didn't matter what the words exchanged between us might have been. Nothing mattered but that God had heard from His throne and allowed me to speak to my son.

God is Awesome. His name is worthy to be praised. He has followed His Creation from the beginning



of time. I read the first three chapters of Genesis this morning. Some may consider me one of those "fools" who believes that God created everything then rested, all in a literal seven day period. My God is that Awesome. He gave me life in 1949 and then gave me new life in 1963. This is my 50th year walking in a personal relationship with Him. Oh yes, He was the one who answered my prayers that day too.

New Laptop Computer




