The Destiny of Democracy Is in Your Hands . . .

At about the time our original 13 states adopted their new constitution, in the year 1787, Alexander Tyler (a Scottish history professor at The University of Edinborough) had this to say about "The Fall of The Athenian Republic" some 52,000 years prior.

"A democracy is always temporary in nature; it simply cannot exist as a permanent form of government. A democracy will continue to exist up until the time that voters discover that they can vote themselves generous gifts from the public treasury. From that moment on, the majority always votes for the candidates who promise the most benefits from the public treasury, with the result that every democracy will finally collapse due to loose fiscal policy, (which is) always followed by a dictatorship."

"The average age of the worlds greatest civilizations from the beginning of history, has been about 200 years. During those 200 years, these nations always progressed through the following sequence:

From Bondage to spiritual faith; From spiritual faith to great courage; From courage to liberty; From liberty to abundance; From abundance to complacency; From complacency to apathy; From apathy to dependence; From dependence back into bondage."

Professor Joseph Olson of Hamline University School of Law, St. Paul, Minnesota, points out some interesting facts concerning the most recent Presidential election:

Population of counties won by: Gore=127 million / Bush=143 million; Square miles of land won by: Gore=580,000 / Bush=2,2427,000; States won by: Gore=19 / Bush=29

Murder rate per 100,000 residents in counties won by: Gore=13.2 / Bush=2.1

Professor Olson adds: "In aggregate, the map of the territory Bush won was mostly the land owned by the tax-paying citizens of this great country. Gore's territory mostly encompassed those citizens living in government-owned tenements and living off government welfare..."

Olson believes the U.S. is now somewhere between the "complacency and "apathy" phase of Professor Tyler's definition of democracy; with some 40 percent of the nation's population already having reached the "governmental dependency" phase.

Excerpts from Reagan's first inaugural address as governor of California January 5, 1967

"Government is the people's business, and every man, woman and child becomes a shareholder with the first penny of tax paid. With all the profound wording of the Constitution, probably the most meaningful

words are the first three: "We, the People." Those of us here today who have been elected to constitutional office or legislative position are in that three-word phrase. We are of the people, chosen by them to see that no permanent structure of government ever encroaches on freedom or assumes a power beyond that freely granted by the people. We stand between the taxpayer and the tax spender.

It is inconceivable to me that anyone could accept this delegated authority without asking God's help. I pray that we who legislate and administer will be granted wisdom and strength beyond our own limited power; that with Divine guidance we can avoid easy expedients, as we work to build a state where liberty under law and justice can triumph, where compassion can govern, and wherein the people can participate and prosper because of their government and not in spite of it."

President Reagan had a clear picture of his purpose here on earth. His focus was simple and to the point. When he was shot and nearly assassinated, he stated that he saw even more clearly that there was a battle between light and darkness in the world. He saw America as a beacon of light. He was convinced that God had something special for him to do. God has something special for each of us to accomplish for the kingdom. When His purposes are finished, He will call us home. We have the best of both worlds; we can choose to serve a loving God here on earth and then spend eternity with Him. What could be better?

Pastors Need Prayer Too ...

Pray that your Pastor and his wife will find real JOY in ministry. It is easy to be caught up with the constant challenge of the needs of people. A Pastor's vision can be clouded by the reality that the work of ministry is never done. Spiritual struggles can drain the soul of your Pastor and

leave him spiritually dull. No one wants to put on a mask and pretend to be joyful when his heart is aching or numb. Joy in the midst of struggles comes from a deepening relationship with God and is an evidence of spiritual maturity (Psalm 51:12).

Allow your Pastor the time needed to maintain a deep and growing relationship with God. This cannot be artificially induced nor does it come in a speedy seminar format. It comes only from spending time alone with God.

Joy and happiness are quite distinct. Joy is not the absence of pain but the presence of God. Joy is determined by our inner man; happiness is determined by our outward circumstances. Loss of joy is one of the first evidences of a strained love relationship. Joy is a by-product of our deepening love for God (John 15:11).
