# Enormous Loss of Pastors Reported

A report, by Dr. Sam Logan, presented at the annual meeting of the Fellowship of Evangelical Seminary Presidents (FESP), indicates U.S. Pastors are 'dropping like flies.' There is an incredible dropout rate. FESP met in Coronado, CA January 2 through 4, 2003.

Included was a survey from "Focus on the Family" that indicates on the average, across the country and across all denominations, 1,800 ministers leave the ministry *every month!* That's 21,600 pastors a year—an attrition rate of 2 to 3 an hour.

"What are churches doing that are driving away the shepherds?"

Less obvious though, is the fact that more ministers are leaving the ministry than all U.S. accredited seminaries combined re replacing!

Significantly, church buildings could sit empty, be boarded up or be turned into commercial property. A bulwark segment of American society and history, possibly even American architecture, may be vanishing and are—at least, on the endangered species list.
