# Thoughts from Diane . . . "TRUTH"



Elizabeth is one of my fifth grade helpers on my elementary route. I lovingly call them my "bosses" and they value the position. I observe character qualities before I make a choice to have them help me. It's a coveted position and not a decision made in haste. They can be chosen as young as third grade and serve until they enter middle school. There have been times I've had to ask one to step down from his/her

position. I expect the truth from all of them. One afternoon, there was huge soda pop spilt in the back of my bus. I found the lovely surprise at the end of the route. I was not happy about it, especially since



they're not to even have open pop on the bus. I was determined to track down the truth. I had a good idea who the culprit was. I started with privately questioning my bosses. That's where Elizabeth comes in; she immediately told me who "did it" and was very adamant. I pulled aside students and when I got through the process, found out that Elizabeth just flat out lied to me. She finally admitted that she had the drink. However, she didn't just lie, she lied in degrees. She said she did it but said it was in her back pack and it just "leaked out." I told her a leak doesn't cover the bottom of four seats and down the aisle. She is not a "boss" now and she's now in an assigned seat. She still hasn't admitted the whole truth and has lost privileges because of it, yet she won't apologize and be done with the lie.

Psalm 51:6 "Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart." One of the things that God has shown me this year is how completely truthful we


