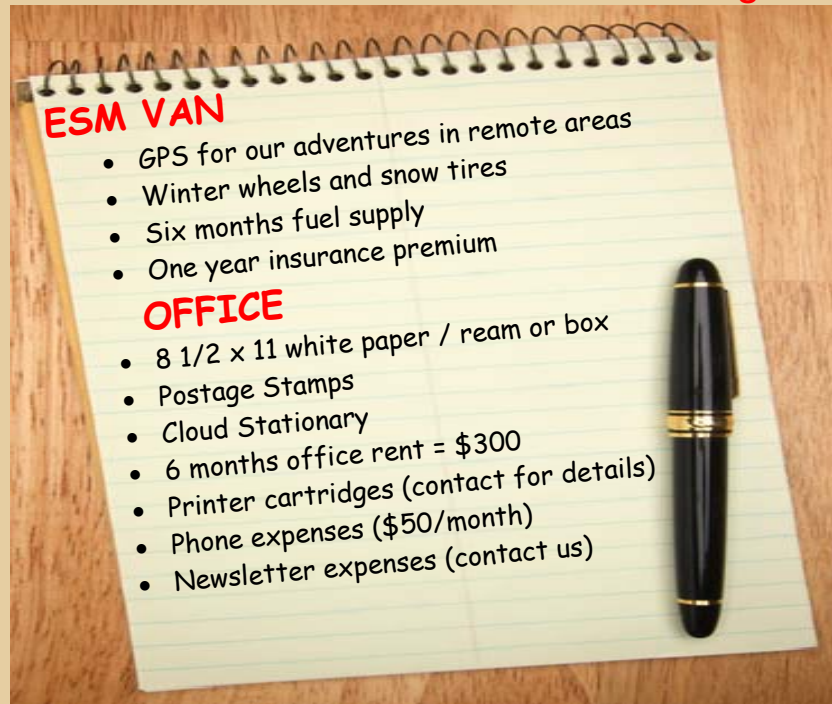

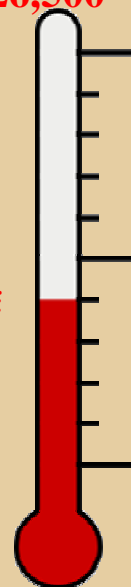

"Praise the Lord! Sing to the Lord a new song, his praise in the assembly of the godly!" Psalm 149:1



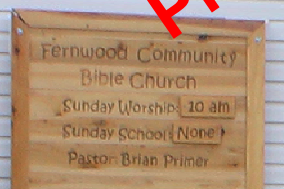

- Continual prayer for safety as we travel.

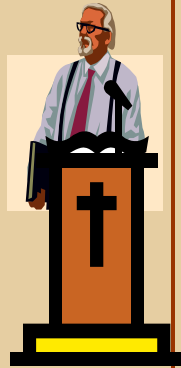
