Mission Trip to Central Mexico

trip). I will be working with a veteran missionary, Steve Montgomery, and sixteen national churches. I will be training nationals in the use of puppetry, ventriloquism (for anyone interested) and basic Gospel magic as outreach tools. The purpose is capture attention, to reach the lost with the Gospel message.

I will be arriving in Guadalajara, MX on July 15th, returning home on July 30th from Puerto Viallarta. We will spend a day gathering needed supplies to construct puppets on the 16th. Then follows four workshops lasting three days each in four different locations. Two of these training settings will also involve Vacation Bible School programs. We will be making puppets and learning how to use them along with any immediate outreach opportunities.

I will be staying in different homes. The older I get, the more of a challenge this is. I will be eating different foods and hopefully not drinking the water. Please pray with us that I will maintain good health and stamina. Pray that language and cultural differences will not be a hindrance. Pray that I can be effective in ministry and build a good rapport with the people. Pray also for Steve Montgomery in regard to his health. He hopes to be able to travel with me for the entire trip, but he is recovering from cancer surgery and is uncertain if his health will allow him to do so.

We have most of our preparations in place. I have reproduced plans for constructing puppets to leave for at least four churches. A workbook has been sent ahead for translation. A friend, Nadine Hopp, has made dozens and dozens of puppets over the years. She is no longer using them so she is sending many of them with me for the churches to use. I will probably have extra baggage charges to transport these.
