For nearly twenty years, Pastor Kevin Ch'en, his wife, Janell and a ministry team have faithfully served in the East Sprague district to the homeless, to drug addicts and others with behavioral problems. Mending Fences Fellowship is located at 1906 E. Sprague Avenue, in the heart of a very challenging neighborhood. To supplement income, Pastor Kevin builds and repairs fences. The construction business is called

Mending Fences & More, Inc. As you may imagine, bridging the ministry of mending fences spiritually and physically is most challenging. I have served as an advisor on the Mending Fences ministry team for about ten years. There have been unique challenges and opportunities. The most recent challenge has been the need to replace the church furnace. This need was sudden and unexpected.

Housed in an older building, there have been a number of surprises that have taxed their limited financial resources. Here's an opportunity for us to help and encourage. The total cost was about \$4,000. They were able to get some rebate assistance for a furnace upgrade and had the unit installed. The ministry has a small financial reserve, but this expense has been a drain. PASTOR KEVIN, MENDING FENCES

JESUS DID NOT ACTUALLY SAY THAT HE WAS GOD. Have you heard this statement before?

If I am able to leave a person with one question with which to wrestle, I have asked this, "Is Jesus who He said He was?" Consider the following: JESUS CHRIST ALONE CLAIMED TO BE GOD IN HUMAN FLESH.

- He said that he who has seen Him (Jesus) has seen the Father (John 14:9).
- He said that He existed before Abraham (John 8:58).
- He said that He was equal with the Father (John 5:17, 18).
- Jesus claimed the ability to forgive sins (Mark 2:5–7), which was something only God could do (Isaiah 43:25).
- John 14:6 Jesus stood before the disciples and said, "I am the way the truth and the life, no man comes to the Father but through me." Imagine being on scene and hearing those words. What would you have thought? He, Jesus, is the ONLY way to the Father, to Heaven. Is He really claiming that which only God could offer?
- The enemies of Jesus knew that He claimed deity. John 10: 30-34 "I and the Father are one.' The Jews picked up stones again to stone him. . . "It is not for a good work that we are going to stone you but for blasphemy . . . being a man, make yourself God." The Jewish adversarial audience understood clearly what Jesus was saying.
- John 1:1 "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God." The Word is Jesus, God in the flesh, Who was there "in the beginning." That One Who was "in the beginning," was God alone.
- The New Testament equated Jesus as the creator of the universe (John 1:3).
- Jesus is the One who holds everything together (Colossians 1:17).
- The apostle Paul says that God was manifest in the flesh (I Timothy 3:16).

Some have denied that Jesus ever existed. The Jewish historian, Flavius Josephus (A.D. 37 – c. 100) not only attested to the fact that Christ walked on earth, but that Jesus was not an ordinary man. Josephus wrote the following in his Antiquities 18:63, "About this time lived Jesus, a wise man, if indeed one ought to call him a man. For he was the achiever of extraordinary deeds and was a teacher of those who accept the truth gladly... He was the Messiah. When ... Pilate condemned him to be crucified, those who had come to love him originally did not cease to do so; for he appeared to them on the third day restored to life, as the prophets of the Deity had foretold . . ."

THE TESTIMONY OF TWO BROTHERS OF JESUS

James 1:1 "James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ . . ."

Jude 1:1, 4 "Jude a servant of Jesus Christ and a brother of James . . ." ". . . Jesus Christ our only Sovereign and Lord."

If there ever was an opportunity to expose Jesus as a fraud, it would be from the pen of those who knew Him best. James and Jude were the half-brothers of Jesus. James and Jude grew up in the same home as Jesus. There must have been times when the siblings of Jesus grew tired of their Mom saying, "Kids, stop that! Why can't you act more like Jesus?" J In their letters, James and Jude had the perfect opportunity to let readers know the truth if Jesus was not who He said He was. James and Jude affirmed the deity of their half-brother, Jesus, by referring to Him as "Lord" (master), "Jesus" (savior), "Christ" (messiah). Why would they perpetuate a lie? The words of these two brothers provide incredibly persuasive evidence as to the deity of Jesus.

The central proof that Jesus was the Son of God was His resurrection from the dead. "And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins." 1 Corinthians 15:17 When asked for a sign from the religious leaders, Jesus replied, "For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the whale, so will the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth" (Matthew 12:40). "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up... but he spoke of the temple of his body" (John 2:19, 21).
