Sometimes the mind acts like a camera. There are clear and colorful images that never go away. When I came to understand my sinfulness and God led me to forgiveness, my love changed into something that I can only say was God given. The kind of love He showed to me was greater than anything I'd ever known. I came to realize that my family needed Christ.

I loved my brothers and I still do. Right now I'm thinking back to when I was fifteen years old. My older brother Bobby was in a horrible car accident.

All three boys in the car were killed. It was winter, icy and they had been driving at very high speeds and ended up crashing into a bridge abutment. Their deaths were horrific and instant. There are many memories of that time and one came to mind recently. I was packed into a huge black car with my family at the end of the service. We were on our way to the cemetery. I was in utter despair and my newfound faith was being tested in the hardest of circumstances. I was by the window that was facing the side of the church. While looking out the window, there was my youth pastor and mission's pastor, just standing and our eyes locked. There are no words to express how those men of God were so much more than an encouragement to me. They were sent from God for a moment in time that I will never forget.

Proverbs 10:25 "When the storm has swept by, the wicked are gone, but the righteous stand firm forever." Yes, I was shaken by a storm, however God sent two men to hold me up and helped me to stand firm in my faith. It was a remarkable fraction of a second. There were still moments of despair, still huge obstacles to push through and awful grief. I want to be clear that life brings these moments to pass. As I've read Ecclesiastes recently it's obvious that it's all a part of life and life is hard at times. Ecclesiastes 7:2 says "...for death is the destiny of every man; the living should take this to heart."

There will be many storms in this life. It reminded me of fairly contemporary hymn. I'll write a few words from the chorus:

"Till the storm passes over, till the thunder sounds no more; till the clouds roll forever from the sky, hold me fast, let me stand, in the hollow of Thy hand; keep me safe till the storm passes by." He has kept me safe and will until the day I go to live with Jesus forever.


