WHO'S THE ENEMY?



My dad and mom loved each other. My dad was a man, and my mom was a woman. Unlike our newest Supreme Court justice, I understood the difference. A biology degree was not required. Right was right and wrong was wrong. Left was left and right was right. Directions, right and wrong and personal identity were not determined by how one felt on a particular day or at a particular hour. Gender fluidity was non-existent. Our nation had a moral compass. Without a moral compass, with every man doing what is right in his own eyes (Judges 21:25), we have today's chaos.

I recently heard a male, pretending to be a woman, say that he wanted to be a mother. He knew that someday that would happen. He was recently seen by our President and praised for his lifestyle. That is delusional. There is a spiritual, mental, and emotional issue here. That man is wasting his life's energy on something that is never going to happen. What is the origin of such delusional thinking?

What is even more disturbing is that I am supposed to agree that such deluded thinking is perfectly normal and possible. If I don't agree, then I am the problem. We are told repeatedly to "follow the science." Then we are told that men can be women and women can become men. Men can even have babies. One can believe this lie, but the science says that is impossible. The truth is that no matter the hormone treatment, no matter the surgery, no matter the mental gymnastics, chromosomal makeup cannot be changed. That is determined by God at birth. The male chromosome is XY. The female chromosome is XX. That is "the science." That cannot be altered. Truth is truth. "And for this reason, God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie . . ." 2 Thessalonians 2:9-12 I realize this is referring to events after the rapture, but we see samples of this delusional thinking today.

When's the last time you saw a group of lions debating gender. When have you ever seen a male lion or dog or elk pretending to be a female? That is absurd. It's time to say that. We can say it kindly, but it must be said. It is not my concern what consenting adults do in private. I don't want to know. Keep it private. Why do some think it is necessary to flaunt abnormal sexual behavior and then to sell it as normal? Don't force me to accept the unnatural as natural. I will not.

Isn't that the point of a "gay pride parade," flaunting what they do in private. The openly lewd and vulgar displays at these events used to be grounds for arrest. Scripture is clear, "Pride goes before destruction and a haughty spirit before a fall." Proverbs 16:18. Should there be a heterosexual pride parade? In some school districts, children are being subjected to these vile and explicit acts in class-rooms and libraries by teachers and "drag queens." There are books in some public-school libraries promoting this lifestyle and gender change with language so explicit that it was banned from being quoted in a school board meeting. "Therefore, God gave them up in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, to the dishonoring of their bodies

For this reason, God gave them up to dishonorable passions. For their women exchanged natural relations for those that are contrary to nature; and the men likewise gave up natural relations with women and were consumed with passion for one another, men committing shameless acts with men and receiving in themselves the due penalty for their error. And since they did not see fit to

acknowledge God, God gave them up to a debased mind to do what ought not to be done. Romans 1:24-28

That baby in a manger, God in human form, humbled Himself to bring us freedom from the bondage of sin. He came to declare truth to a lost and dying world that is falling for a lie. This lie is from the "father of lies," Satan himself. He is **THE REAL ENEMY**. He is the one who is out to "steal, kill, and destroy." He loves chaos and confusion. In this setting, he works best. Remember who the real enemy is. Pray for and love those who are caught in his web of deceit. But for the grace of God, there go I.

Thoughts from Dawna... Are You Hurt or Are You Injured?

When you think about a person in Scripture who suffered in pain and shared those experiences most fully, you might think of Job. Job was a unique character, righteous and wealthy. He knew many luxuries that the world had to offer but overall, he feared God and shunned evil. Job faced the ultimate human sufferings at the hand of Satan. He personally knew the effects of physical, emotional, intellectual, and spiritual pain.

ARE YOU HURT?

When my oldest son played football in high school, one of the most important things the coaches taught the boys at the beginning of each season was to know the difference between being hurt and being injured. Both hurt and injury cause pain but the reaction to each



of these things should be different. When you play football, you're going to hurt. Practices are long and hard. Your muscles are going to scream in pain, resisting movement, and it'll hurt worse two days later. You'll be bruised, worn out, and feel physically broken. You are hurt, you are in pain, but you are not injured. You can continue to move forward even in the pain that's caused by being hurt.

ARE YOU INJURED?

When injury happens, you are a victim to the result of that injury. The consequence of injury is that you must take time off to heal. Injury will stop you from playing football and in life, injury will stop you from doing the work you set out to do. Injury requires rest, recovery and healing which means the response to injury should be much different than the response to being hurt.

THE MOST EFFECTIVE RESPONSE TO PAIN

Just like being hit hard in the game of football, our everyday lives come with pain whether it's physical, emotional, or spiritual. However, ninety-eight percent of the time we are experiencing pain from being hurt but we react as though we are critically injured. That is, abandoning relationships, quitting jobs, outbursts of anger, and other forms of self-

medication. These are all a giant overreaction to being hurt.

It is imperative to recognize that most of the hurt in our lives is something we can push through despite the pain. Like Job in the Bible said, "Then I would still have this consolation — my joy in unrelenting pain — that I had not denied the words of the Holy One." When you're ready to learn from and emulate a person who has experienced that kind of pain, read Job's stories. Focus on his words, actions, and responses to pain.

A football coach teaches his players that if you don't learn to understand the difference between being hurt and being injured, pain will take you out of the game every single time. Most importantly, pain is ever present if we're alive, and it's a waste of life if you allow it to diminish the work and productivity of a lifetime well-lived for God.

Hebrews 12:11 No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of right-eousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.
